

Transformative, accountable and liberatory masculinities

A dialogue of intersections, tensions and difference in therapeutic conversation

Sacha, Stefan and Steve will address their theory and practice working alongside men and masculine identified people. The multiple locations of these therapists invite diverse practices and responses to the influences of problematic masculinities; each aims to discern accountable and liberatory masculinities from patriarchy. Challenging dominant, hegemonic and hetero-cisnormative masculinities, this dialogue will offer some hope-filled resistance to abuses of power and domination. Our aim is to create space for liberatory transformations for both the men and masculine identified people we work alongside, and communities, with an aim to transform our social context.
